He is now associated with First Light stock agency, the 2nd largest stock agency in Canada, and is finally available for commercial and private photo shoots after a two and half year break. During that time he was busy building his Assistants24h.com web site (Professional Photography Database) and 100portfolios.com - web site design for visual artists across Canada.

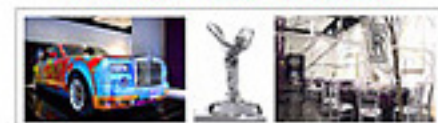
